1. The Ministry of Public Works has received funds from the Ministry of Finance and Development Planning towards the cost of **Public Sector Investment Project** and intends to apply part of the funds to cover the eligible payments under contracts for the Pavement of Community Roads in Monrovia and its environs and Buchanan Cities.
2. The Ministry of Public Works (MPW) intends to undertake the community roads pavement project using both Local and International Contractors/Firms.
3. Bidders will be required to satisfy the Qualification Criteria given in the Bidding Documents. Bidders, either as a single entity or in joint venture, **MUST** meet the following requirements on eligibility:
  - i. Bidders or each of the Joint Venture parties should not have a pending or ongoing litigation worth more than 50% of their net worth;
  - Minimum average annual construction turnover, in the case of an International or Joint venture, US\$5.0 million and in the case of a Liberia own construction company US\$0.5 million within the last three (3) years as a Contractor;
  - A cash flow of US\$1.27 million for a period of four months in the last two calendar years for International Firms and Joint Ventures, in the case of Liberian owned companies US\$100,000.00.
  - Experience in at least two (2) contracts of similar nature as a Contractor or Subcontractor within the last seven (7) years, each with a value of at least US\$2.0 million that have been successfully or substantially completed as prime contractor.

- Completed priced Bill of Quantities

4. The Ministry of Public Works (MPW) – **(the Implementing Agency)** invites sealed bids for the pavement of community roads in Monrovia and its environs including Buchanan City. International Competitive Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the **amended and restated Public Procurement and Concessions Act of Liberia, 2005** as Revised in September 2010.

5. International Competitive Bidding will be conducted in accordance with the Single Stage – One-Envelope procedure for Procurement of Works and is opened to all qualify Bidders.

6. Bids will be sold to all interested Companies.

7. Each bidder/JVCA (Joint Venture, Consortium/Association) shall submit only one bid for a lot or a combination of lots but a winning bidder can be considered for two lots only.
8. Interested and eligible bidders may obtain further information from, and inspect the bidding documents at the **Ministry of Public Works Procurement Division from 9:00 am to 4:00 pm daily beginning Tuesday August 28, 2018 to Monday, October 8, 2018.**
9. A complete set of bid documents in English can be purchased by any interested eligible bidder upon payment of a non-refundable fee of US\$ 500.00 (Five Hundred United States Dollars) or its equivalent in Liberian dollars, through the Liberia Revenue Authority and bring the Flag Receipt to the Ministry of Public Works Financial Management Division for the issuance of MPW Official Receipt to pick-up the Bidding Document from the Procurement Division of the Ministry.
